

East York Basketball Club (“EYBC”) COVID Vaccination Policy

In accordance with the Ontario Government’s vaccine policy along with the Ontario Basketball Association (“OBA”) Return to Play guidelines, the Board of the EYBC has approved the following:

- **all participants 12 years of age or older must be fully vaccinated no later than October 31, 2021** (or have a valid and acceptable exemption) to be eligible to play this upcoming season in both our HL & Rep Programs.
- **all coaches, managers, volunteers, front desk & coordinators are required to be fully vaccinated no later than September 22 2021** (or have a valid and acceptable exemption);
- **no spectators will be allowed in our HL Program at this time.** Should this change, all spectators, 12 years of age or older, will be required to show proof of full vaccination (or have a valid and acceptable exemption) to the front desk;
- **no spectators will be allowed in our Rep practices at this time.** During competitions, spectators will be dependent upon the government, OBA and the facilities rules & regulations. Should this change, all spectators, 12 years of age or older, will be required to show proof of full vaccination (or have a valid and acceptable exemption) to the coach/manager;
- those under 12 years of age are exempt from the above, however, we will continue to follow guidance from governing authorities;

Please note:

- For clarity, full vaccination is defined as being 14 calendar days past having received a second dose of an approved COVID-19 vaccine;
- **In order to provide proof of vaccination, you must show your vaccination certificate, along with identification, to the front desk (for HL) or to the coach/manager (for Rep). The vaccination certificate can download from <https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/> or by contacting the Ministry of Health at 1-888-999-6488;**
- **At no time will we be collecting personal and/or confidential information.** We shall only record that your vaccination status has been confirmed. *You are only required to provide proof of vaccination once, although the EYBC reserves the right to modify this policy should circumstances necessitate amendment as a result of government or public health requirements or obligation.*

The EYBC will adhere to the Ontario Human Rights Code (OHRC) and will provide accommodation to any individual who is unable to be vaccinated for reasons protected under the OHRC.

Individuals requiring accommodation must provide the EYBC with documentation validating their vaccination exemption. The EYBC reserves the right to have all documentation reviewed by its Agents or Assigns. Where accommodation is not possible, the individual will not be permitted access to EYBC events or until such time the government, OBA and the facilities allow such accommodations.
